Four Stories, key concepts - 1

- Harmful chemicals in everyday things
 - Food, water, air, consumer products, etc
 - Some last long time / don't break down
 - What we don't know <u>can</u> harm us.





No escape from exposure













- Pollution gets into our bodies
 - Daily re-exposure
 - Build up over time



Sharpe and Irvine, BMJ 2004



- Most vulnerable during key growth phases
 - babies, young children, pregnant women
 - Timing of even small amounts are a big deal



- Pollution makes us more likely to get sick
 - Cancer: breast, prostate, testicular, ...
 - Metabolic: diabetes, obesity,
 - **Reproductive:** fertility, pregnancy
 - Neurological: learning / attention deficit / IQ
 - Other: asthma & allergies,

- Combinations can be more harmful (cocktail effect)

Four Stories, key concepts - 3

- Absence of proof of harm does not equal proof of safety -> PRECAUTION is necessary
- Safer alternatives exist
