Where?

With the continuing success of the original French campaign that has been running since 2006, more and more countries join the event, In 2012, **21 countries** took part in the event (mostly in Europe and Africa).

Our goal is to inspire the most organizations possible to take advantage of a common date across the world to get mobilized on pesticides issues.

When?

The event takes place every year from **March 20th to 30th**. The first 10 days of Spring are symbolically important as it is the resumption of pesticide treatments.
