Interested applicants must fulfil all of the following criteria:

- University degree in public health, communications/media or environment/energy or relevant professional experience
- Being a Bengaluru local with excellent written and spoken English

We're looking for someone with:

- Understanding of the health arguments and evidence around air pollution and ability to quickly synthesize this information for various stakeholders
- Excellent communication, writing, and presentation skills
- Existing contacts and network of Indian health and medical professionals and/or soft skills to reach out to such groups and expand HEAL network
- Excellent interpersonal skills, self-starter, flexibility and reliability
- Willingness to travel

Responsibilities will include:

- Strengthening of relations with existing stakeholders on health and air pollution issues and building a coalition of health professionals, as well as outreach
- Provide health evidence and messaging for local and regional health experts and groups engaged to find solutions to Bengaluru's air pollution problem
- Assist in identifying policy opportunities around which engagement of the health community could be centered
- Organise meetings, workshops and webinars
- Reach out to media and pitch air pollution and health stories as relevant
- Linking UMC Bengaluru back to the international UMC campaign
